THIS is a synopsis of the *Cappella Archive* combined roman and italic Baskerville typeface. It is digitized as a letterpress fount so, unlike commercial fonts, there are no kerned pairs, and each character has a fixed width. It is based on a Fry's Baskerville of 1769 and took about three months to compile. There are 236 characters which are playable without mousework from the Macintosh keyboard, which has been remapped into a typesetting one. The accents may be inserted by keying after any chosen character, such as è, é, ö, ô, ç, and the five spaces available are em. .en. .normal. .thin..plus hair, thin reverse, and hair reverse. This synopsis is a type 1 version for PDF display and there are a few absent glyphs; the pearl and ligatured st and ct, present at * in the type 3 original.
